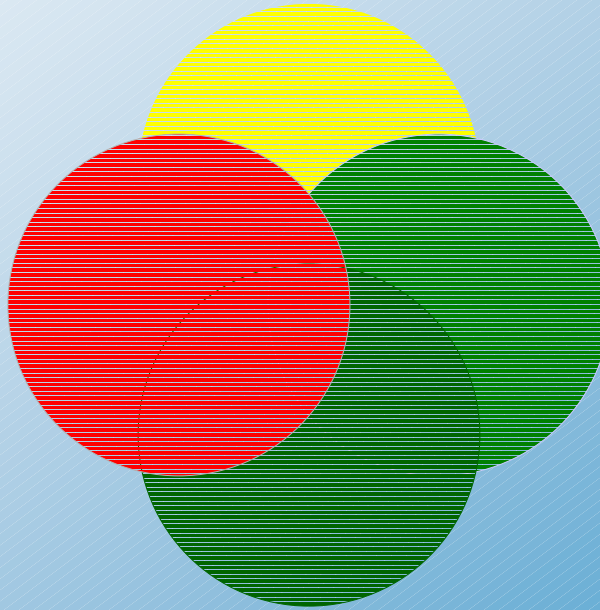

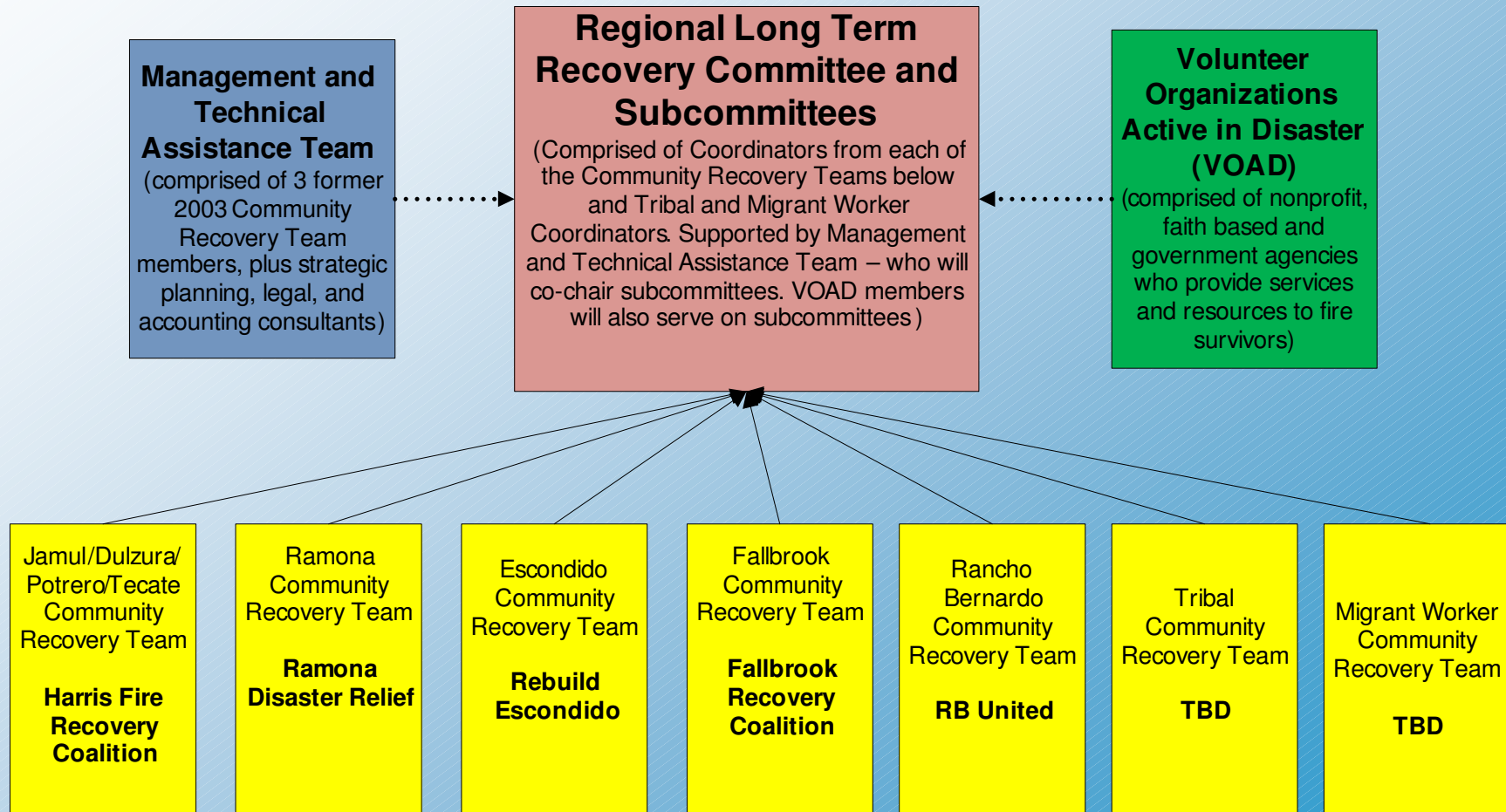

Regional Needs Identified

- Survivor Need Priorities:
 - Housing
 - Temporary
 - Insurance Claims Assistance
 - Long-Term Rebuilding Assistance
 - Health and Human Services
 - Case management and support for vulnerable populations
 - Short and long-term access to counseling services

Regional Needs Identified

- Civic Engagement Priority Needs
 - Community Recovery Team Support
 - Centralized Case Management Support
- Environment Priority Needs
 - Erosion control
 - Debris and hazardous waste remove
 - Water quality (ground water)
 - Scientific-based habitat monitoring and restoration
 - Animal welfare

Regional Needs Identified

- Preparedness Priority Needs
 - First responder/support agencies equipment and training
 - Networks for trained volunteers to support all disaster phases
 - Plans, training and equipment for individuals, households, families, work places and communities

Priority Needs as of Today

- Regional
 - Case management
 - Access to counseling services
 - Support to vulnerable populations
 - Legal aid support
 - Insurance claims support
 - Gift cards (Gas/Groceries/Household Items)
 - Storage

Priority Needs as of Today

- Specific Community Needs
 - Water
 - Utility Poles
 - Generators
 - Septic Tanks
 - Tools
 - Seeds & Trees



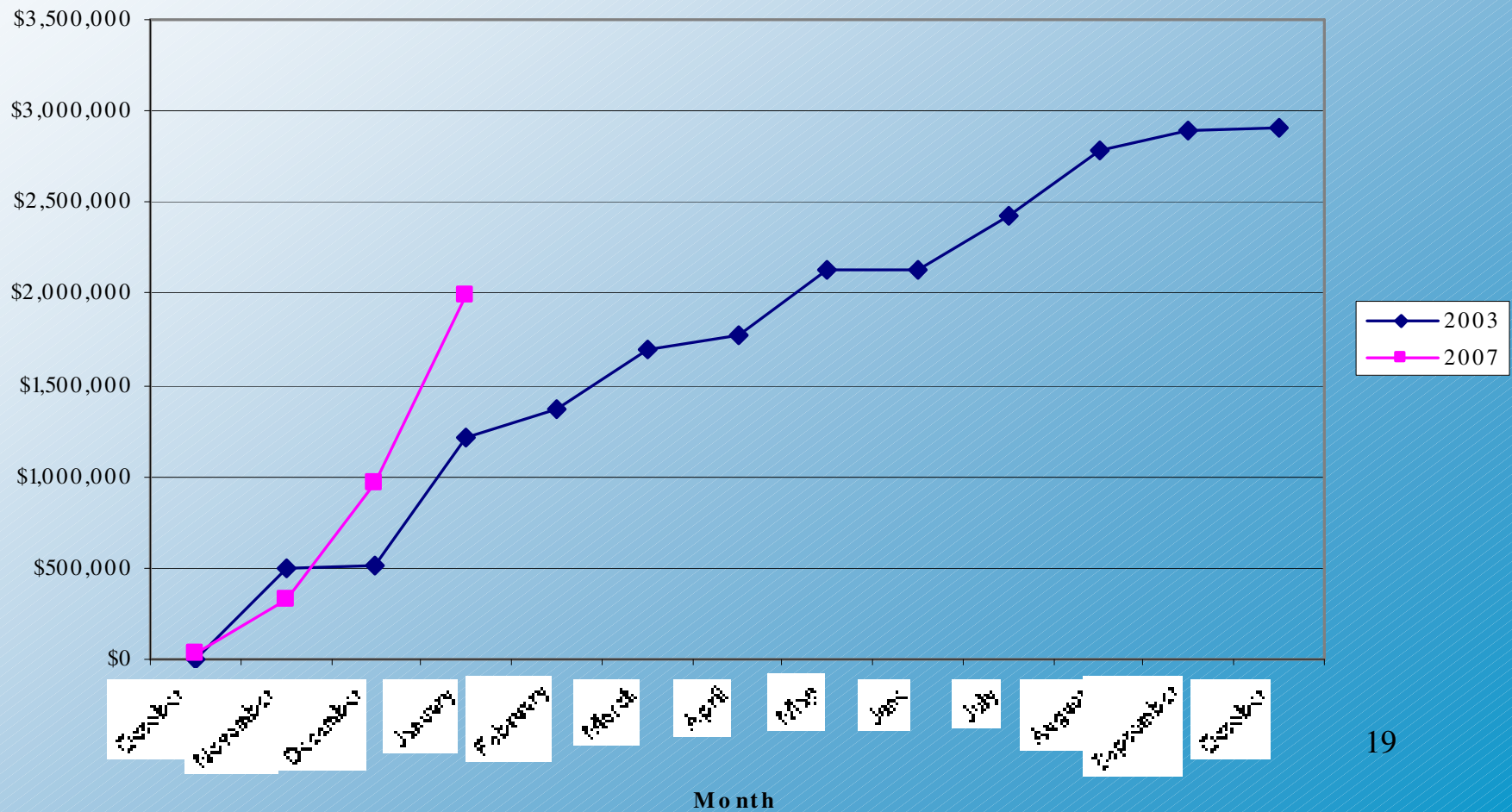
The San Diego Regional Disaster Fund

- After the Fire Funds Available: \$7,886,897
- Grants funds approved to date: \$1,989,127
- Grants in final stages of approval: \$646,000
